

PLEASANT HILL VILLAGE COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
NOVEMBER 20TH, 2006
MINUTES

Mayor Gary Johnston called the meeting to order at 7:02pm. It was noted that this is a special meeting for the purpose of discussion and action in the hiring of a Village maintenance employee. Gary reported that Ronald (Bud) Perry had been sworn in as a Council Member of the Village of Pleasant Hill. Roll Call: Melinda Clark, Donna Favorite, Robert (Bob) Sollmann, John Schultz, Rick Baker, and Ronald (Bud) Perry all present. Others present were Jeff Derksen, Service Superintendent; Gary Johnston, Mayor; and Debbie Cress, Income Tax Administrator.

Gary read Lonnie Robbin's letter declining the Assistant to the Service Superintendent position and made the letter available to the Council. Gary reported that Tim Byrd was the interview committee's very close second choice, and shared resume and interview highlights. Interview committee members Rick and Bob stated that they felt Tim was very well qualified. Donna questioned if there would be any physical limitations, and Rick and Bob replied no. Bob further commented that Tim would not need insurance because he is covered by his spouse, which would save the village \$6,000 per year. Rick commented that he would expect Tim to remain in the position for about ten years.

Bob made a motion to hire Tim Byrd for the position of Assistant to the Service Superintendent at \$13.50 per hour for a six month probationary period, and at the end of six months of satisfactory performance that rate be increased \$.50 per hour. John seconded. Roll call: Donna, Bob, John, Rick, Bud, and Melinda all yes. Motion carried. It was discussed that Tim would need to give two weeks notice to his previous employer.

Melinda made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Donna seconded. Roll call: Bob, John, Rick, Bud, Melinda, and Donna all yes. Meeting adjourned at 7:10pm.
