ORDINANCE 932

AN ORDINANCE TO RATIFY ABOLISHMENT OF MAYOR'S COURT

WHEREAS, The Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio has in the past operated a Mayor's Court and;

WHEREAS, the expense and liability of maintaining the Mayor's Court has outweighed the benefit;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio

SECTION ONE: That the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill ratifies the abolishment of the Mayor's Court in the Village of Pleasant Hill.

SECTION TWO: That all persons currently employed in the Mayor's Court are hereby removed from said position.

SECTION THREE: That all ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio for the aforementioned reasons and therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
