ORDINANCE 942

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A SIXTY (60) MINUTE PARKING ZONE AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the parking of vehicles at 6 East Monument Street is a safety hazard;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio a majority of its members elected or appointed therefore concurring as follows:

SECTION ONE: That a sixty (60) minute parking zone is hereby declared at Six East Monument Street in the village of Pleasant Hill between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. weekdays and 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Saturdays.

SECTION TWO: That any violation of this ordinance shall be a minor misdemeanor. Each 24-hour period of violation constitutes a separate offense.

SECTION THREE: That Section 4 of Ordinance 818 Designating 15 minute parking at 8 East Monument Street is repealed.

SECTION FOUR: That all ordinances and resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby modified consistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio for the reason that said Ordinance will alleviate an unsafe condition that occurs on an ongoing basis and therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
