Ordinance 950

AN ORDINANCE FOR SQUEALING TIRES,
"PEELING", CRACKING EXHAUST NOISES
IN THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds and declares that squealing tires and loud exhaust of motor vehicles are an ongoing problem within the Village limits; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds that adopting an ordinance to deter squealing tires and loud exhausts is in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Pleasant Hill; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, a majority of the members elected or appointed thereto concurring.

SECTION ONE: No person shall unnecessarily race the motor of any vehicle and no person shall operate any motor vehicle, except in an emergency, in such a manner that the vehicle is so rapidly accelerated or started from a stopped position, that the exhaust system emits a loud, cracking or chattering noise, unusual to its normal operation, or whereby the tires of such vehicle squeal or leave tire marks on the roadway, commonly called "peeling".

SECTION TWO: Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall take affect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
