ORDINANCE 955

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A FOUR WAY STOP

WHEREAS the in intersection of Locust Street and High Street in the Village is a safety hazard, and:

WHEREAS, the placement of stop signs at all four directions at the said intersection will diminish the safety hazard.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio, at least three fourths of its members elected or appointed therefore concurring.

SECTION ONE: That there shall be a four way stop at the intersection of Locust Street and High Street in the Village of Pleasant Hill.

SECTION TWO: That any violation of this ordinance shall be in accordance with any punishable according to the corresponding sections of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION THREE: That all Ordinances and Resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby modified to be consistent with this Ordinance.
