

VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, OHIO

ORDINANCE 957

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBITING SOLICITATION
IN THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL

WHEREAS, the Village Council has had difficulty with solicitation becoming a nuisance, and;

WHEREAS, a limitation on solicitation is necessary for the protection of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, with at least three fourths of the members elected or appointed thereto concurring,

SECTION ONE: That no person, firm, or corporation shall engage in the business or activity of a peddler, solicitor, canvasser, itinerant vendor, or transient dealer within the municipality.

SECTION TWO: That this Ordinance shall not apply to any organization located in the Village of Pleasant Hill or Newton Township including but not limited to Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, 4-H clubs, Newton School sanctioned activities and groups sanctioned by churches located within the Village or Township.

SECTION THREE: Groups not specifically listed in Section Two of this Ordinance may give notice of their intention to solicit by sending written notice to the Mayor for the Village of Pleasant Hill thirty days prior to the first date of solicitation.

SECTION FOUR: That any Ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance shall be deemed modified to be consistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio for the aforementioned reasons and therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
