ORDINANCE 958

IMPOSITION OF FEE FOR RETURNED CHECKS

WHEREAS, The Village desires to deter the writing of checks to the Village without sufficient funds; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to recover the cost and inconvenience of dealing with checks without sufficient funds;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio that:

SECTION ONE: A thirty dollar (\$30.00) fee be imposed on any check made payable to the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio or any of its public offices or subsidiaries, that is without sufficient funds.

SECTION TWO: That any Ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance shall be deemed modified to be consistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio for the reason that said Ordinance will aid in providing proper services for the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill and therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
