ORDINANCE 969

AN ORDINANCE ADVANCING FUNDS FROM GENERAL FUND TO POLICE LEVY FUND

WHEREAS, it is necessary to advance funds from the General Fund to the Police Levy Fund in order to keep the Police Levy solvent;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio, at least tree fourths of its members elected or appointed therefore concurring:

SECTION ONE: That funds shall be advanced form the General Fund to the Police Levy Fund in the amount of Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000.00) for the purpose of paying the salaries, benefits, gas and repair to cruisers. The first, Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00), and second, Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00) tax settlements which will come from Miami County Auditor in March and in August will be advanced back to the General Fund for the year 2003.

SECTION TWO: That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio for the reason that the Village of Pleasant Hill has an immediate need to keep the Police Levy Fund solvent therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
