ORDINANCE 982

AN ORDINANCE ADVANCING FUNDS FROM GENERAL FUND TO POLICE LEVY FUND

WHEREAS, it was necessary to advance funds from the General Fund to the Police Levy Fund in order to keep the Police Levy solvent;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio, at least three fourths of its members elected or appointed therefore concurring:

SECTION ONE: Whereas funds were advanced from the General Fund to the Police Levy Fund in the amount of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) for the purpose of paying the salaries, benefits, gas and repair to cruisers. Whereas the Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) came from the Miami County Auditor Tax Settlement in March and will be advanced back to the General Fund for the year 2004 at that time.

SECTION TWO: That the Village Council approves the action of the Village Fiscal Office.

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio for the reason that the Village of Pleasant Hill has an immediate need to keep the Police Levy Fund solvent therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
