ORDINANCE 995

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANIMALS FROM BECOMING
A NUISANCE IN THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL**

WHEREAS, the Village Council has had difficulty with animals becoming a nuisance;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, a majority of the members elected or appointed thereto concurring.

SECTION ONE: That Section 1030 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Pleasant Hill be amended as follows:

1030 Loud animal. No owner, keeper, or harbinger of any animal shall permit or allow such animal to annoy or disturb one or more of the inhabitants of 2 or more separate residences of this municipality by frequent or habitual howling, yelping, barking, or making of any other such noises by such animal within the corporate limits.

Penalty, ~~see Title Ten, Chapter 3, 1070~~ THAT ANY VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE A MINOR MISDEMEANOR.

SECTION TWO: This ordinance shall take affect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
