ORDINANCE 999

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING TRACTOR-TRAILER TRUCKS ON VILLAGE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS, Ordinance 26.7 and Ordinance 457 do not adequately meet the needs for regulating parking of tractor-trailer trucks on the Village streets and highways; and

WHEREAS, the penalty provided in those Ordinances do not meet the current codified penal standards for the State of Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, a majority of the members elected or appointed thereto concurring.

SECTION ONE: No person, firm, corporation, or partnership being the owner or operator of a tractor-trailer truck shall park or cause to be parked a tractor-trailer truck on the streets or highways of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio, except for the specific purpose of loading or unloading said tractor-trailer truck. This Ordinance shall apply to either the tractor-trailer combination or the trailer part of said tractor-trailer truck but not to the tractor part of said tractor-trailer truck.

SECTION TWO: In the event of mechanical failure preventing the movement of the tractor-trailer or trailer part of said tractor-trailer truck, the Village police shall be notified immediately and in such event of mechanical failure said tractor-trailer or trailer part of said tractor-trailer truck shall remain parked no longer than twenty-four hours.

SECTION THREE: A violation of this Ordinance is a minor misdemeanor. Each period of twenty-four hours that a said tractor-trailer or trailer part of said tractor-trailer truck remains parked in violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed a separate offense. This Ordinance shall become a part of the codified Ordinances of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio, upon it being passed into law, and upon the earliest time allowed by law.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio for the reason that Ordinance 26.7 and Ordinance 457 do not adequately meet the needs for

regulating parking of tractor-trailer trucks on the Village streets and highways and the Village will be without means to enforce the Ordinance affecting the safety of the Village, therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
