

**VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, OHIO**

**ORDINANCE 1014**

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT HUNTING OF ANIMALS OR FOWL  
IN THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL**

WHEREAS, the hunting of animals and fowl within the Village limits is a danger to the citizens of the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, a majority of the members elected or appointed thereto concurring that:

SECTION ONE: No person shall hunt, kill, or attempt to kill any game animal or game bird by the use of firearms or any other means

SECTION TWO: Whoever violates any of the provisions of this ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall take affect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
