ORDINANCE 1020

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING RECREATIONAL DEVICES IN TOMMY LEWIS PARK

WHEREAS, there has been a marked increase in the use of recreational devices such as skateboards, roller blades, and bicycles in the park;

WHEREAS, the use of such equipment has caused damage and soiling of the surfaces of the park and its structures;

WHEREAS, use of such equipment also interferes with the flow of pedestrians and other lawful activity by patrons of the park;

WHEREAS, use of such designated devices gives rise to a potential risk of liability to the Village of Pleasant Hill;

WHEREAS, restrictions on the use of such recreational devices is necessary to insure proper ingress and egress to the park and other lawful use thereof, and to prevent damage to and the soiling of the park premises and structures;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio:


SECTION ONE: No person shall use any skates, skateboards, roller blades, or other recreational devices, or ride a bicycle or other self propelled vehicles in the park, its steps, fountains, or structures.


SECTION TWO: Any violation of this Ordinance shall be a minor misdemeanor.
