

**VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, OHIO
ORDINANCE 1046**

AN ORDINANCE OF ASSESSMENT

WHEREAS, The Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio has found that it necessary to make street improvements on East Monument Street

WHEREAS, The Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio needs to allocate funds for these improvements;

WHEREAS, The actual cost of the East Monument Street improvement has been ascertained; and

WHEREAS, On May 12, 2008 the council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio passed Resolution 2008-05, levying special assessments on benefited for the cost of new curbs, gutters, storm drains, and total reconstruction of East Monument Street.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio:

SECTION ONE: The actual costs are hereby assessed in the manner provided in the Resolution of Necessity 2008-05 adopted under section 727.12 of the Ohio Revised Code upon the lots and lands enumerated in the estimated assessment. The portion of the total cost of the improvements to be paid for by special assessments and such assessments as to each lot or parcel of land, shall be increased or decreased in the same proportion to the estimated assessment on each such lot or parcel of land as the actual cost of the improvement bears to the estimated cost of the improvement upon which the estimated assessment was based. Such assessments shall be payable as provided in the Resolution of Necessity 2008-05 and shall be final upon the adoption of this Ordinance.
