Utility Billing Schedule 2020

Village Utility Payments are due dates: November 19th

*If payment is not received by the Payment Due date, a Red TAG Notice will be issued, the amount noted on the bill will be due by 8:00 am of the scheduled shut off day posted on the Red TAG Notice.

Automated Clearing House (ACH) for Utility Bills (water/sewer/refuse)

ACH is a network that coordinates electronic payments and automated money transfers. For the benefit and convenience, the Village of Pleasant Hill is hereby authorized to automatically deduct from your checking/savings account of your utility bill every two months, which includes a \$1.00 convenience fee (Jan, Mar, May, Jul, Sep and Nov) on the 15th day of the month ore the first business day following.

Oakes-Beitman Memorial Library located at 12 North Main Street, Pleasant Hill Ohio has provided the residents of Pleasant Hill and Newton Township with books and DVDs, access to the internet, children's programs, and more since 1957. The branch is an active one with more than 55,000 items being in circulation each year. Summer reading club and story times are very popular.

History: The Oakes-Beitman Memorial Library was established following a bequest by Pleasant Hill native Ellie Wampler who died in 1952. Mrs. Wampler bequeathed her home to be used as a public library with income from the operation of library provided funds generated by farmland also bequeathed by Mrs. Wampler. Ohio law prevented the establishment of a new public library district and income from the farm was in sufficient so the Oakes-Beitman Memorial Library board contracted with the Troy-Miami County Public Library to establish the library which opened in 1957.

Rumpke Single Stream Recycling Guidelines

The Single Stream Recycling allows residential recyclables to be mixed together. They are later sorted at one of Rumpke's advanced recycling facilities. Single stream programs focus on all recyclable materials generated by residents – not just individual items. This comprehensive approach helps divert the greatest volume of recyclable materials from landfills. With single sort recycling, homeowners aren't burdened with the job of separating or sorting their recyclables. Ultimately, this convenience means more people participate, which leads to an overall reduction in waste.

*Acceptable Items for Recycling:

- Glass Bottles & Jars (all colors)
- Metal Cans: Aluminum cans, steel cans and lids, empty aerosol cans with the lids and tips removed
- Plastic Bottles (empty, crush, reattach lid): Bottles and jugs that have a small mouth and wider base, such as milk jugs, soda bottles, laundry detergent bottles, water bottles, shampoo bottles and contact solution bottles
- Paper: newspaper, magazines, cardboard, mixed office paper and envelopes, paperboard (cereal boxes), pizza boxes free of food debris and grease, telephone books and catalogs
- Cartons: food and beverage cartons, such as milk, juice, soup, wine, broth and other cartons.

Village Street Sweeping

Starting the 1st week of December, the Village has contracted to have the streets swept. We will do our best to notify residents of the actual date, which will be based off of weather. Notification will be provided on the Village Website and Village Facebook page.

Street Sweeping provides two primary benefits to the village. The more obvious benefit is the collection and removal of paper, leaves, and other visible debris that collect in the gutters. This debris can block storm water facilities, causing localized flooding during heavy rains. An equally important, but less visible benefit is the removal of metal particles and other hazardous waste products left by passing vehicles. Although they are virtually invisible, these particles can be extremely harmful to fish and other wildlife if they reach our creeks and rivers. The Village encourages residents in the designated areas to move their parked cars off the street before the sweeping date to allow street sweeping crews room to clean streets.
