Ms. Judy Barga has become Mayor, effective June 16th, 2020

Ms. Michelle Foster will be sworn-in at the July 13th meeting filling the vacant Council seat.

*Per the Ohio Revised Code, Title (7) VII Municipal Corporations, Chapter 733: Officers

733.25 Vacancy in office of mayor of village. When the mayor is absent from the village, or is unable for any cause to perform his duties, the president pro tempore of the legislative authority shall be acting mayor. **In case of the death, resignation, or removal of the mayor, such president pro tempore shall become the mayor and shall hold the office until his successor is elected and qualified.** Such successor shall be elected to the office for the unexpired term, at the first regular municipal election that occurs more than forty days after the vacancy has occurred; except that when the unexpired term ends within one year immediately following the date of such election, an election to fill such unexpired term shall not be held and the president of the legislative authority of the city shall hold the office for such unexpired term. Effective Date: 02-17-1972.

Reminder to Residents

Ordinance 1074 – Relating Prohibiting Yard Waste and/or Leaves in Curb Gutters

WHEREAS, placing leaves and yard waste into curb gutters clogs the gutters creating unsafe and unsanitary conditions; and WHEREAS, to prevent unnecessary waste from entering the curb gutters;

SECTION ONE: It is not permissible at any time to sweep, blow, or otherwise place or dispose of grass or vegetation clippings, branches or other yard waste onto sidewalks, streets, curb gutters or other public rights of way.

SECTION TWO: No owner or other person having care of or being in control of land shall allow grass or vegetation clippings, branches or other yard waste to accumulate on said premises longer than one week, without properly disposing of said yard waste.

SECTION THREE: To assist owners or other persons having care of or being in control of properties inside the Village, the Village will have an annual leaf pick-up program. The Village will designate and post the dates for this program. All leaves must be bagged in regular trash bags no larger than 50 gallon size and placed at the lawn side of the curb.

SECTION FOUR: A violation of this Ordinance shall be a minor misdemeanor.
