Village Utility Payment due dates for 2023: July 20th, September 20th, and November 20th.

*Outstanding balances, not paid by the months listed day are subject to 20% penalties. Services will be disconnected if utility bills are not paid within seven (7) calendars after the due date. Upon default, a fifty dollar (\$50.00) administrative fee will be charged to reinstate service.

Payments can be made using cash, check or credit card. The Village offers a Direct Pay Program (ACH) for utility customers. Paperwork can be obtained from the Village website or Village Office.

Attention Village Residents

Village Ordinance 1074: An Ordinance relating to prohibiting yard waste and/or leaves in curb gutters and repealing ordinance No. 1029. **Section One:** It is not permissible at any time to sweep, blow, or otherwise place or dispose of grass or vegetation clippings, branches or other yard waste onto sidewalks, streets, curb gutters or other public rights of way. **Section Two:** No owner or other person having care of or being in control of land shall allow grass or vegetation clippings, branches, or other yard waste to accumulate on said premises longer than one week, without properly disposing of said yard waste.
