Attention Village Residents

Village Ordinance 1074: An Ordinance relating to prohibiting yard waste and/or leaves in curb gutters and repealing ordinance No. 1029. Section One: It is not permissible at any time to sweep, blow, or otherwise place or dispose of grass or vegetation clippings, branches or other yard waste onto sidewalks, streets, curb gutters or other public rights of way. Section Two: No owner or other person having care of or being in control of land shall allow grass or vegetation clippings, branches, or other yard waste to accumulate on said premises longer than one week, without properly disposing of said yard waste.

Village Ordinance 1013: An Ordinance to Prohibit Animals from Becoming A Nuisance In The Village Of Pleasant Hill. Section One: No owner, keeper, or harbinger of any animal shall allow such animal to annoy or disturb one or more of the inhabitants of 2 or more separate residences of this municipality by frequent or habitual howling, yelping, barking, or making of any other such noises by such animal within the corporation limits. Section Two: No person being the owner of any animal or fowl, or harboring or having charge or control of the same, shall permit such animal or fowl to run unfettered in any street, lane, alley, marketplace or public ground of this municipality, or permit such animal or fowl to go upon or enter any private yard, lot, or enclosure, without consent of the owner of such yard, lot, or enclosure. Section Three: No person shall keep any pig, horse, cow, goat, poultry, three or more dogs at least three months of age, or three or more cats at least 3 months of age, within the corporation limits or harbor any animals or fowl so as to create noxious or offensive odors or unsanitary conditions which are a menace to the health, comfort or safety of the public. ****Ordinance 1013 has been explicitly identified, due to a vast population of cats running freely within the Village limits. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.**

Reminder to Pet (Dog) Owners

All pet owners and keepers are requested to keep their pets on a leash and immediately and properly dispose of their pet's solid waste deposited on any property, public or private, not owned or possessed by the person. On any property owned or possessed by that person, all pet owners and keepers are requested to dispose of their pet's solid waste at a frequency of at least weekly or more frequently if necessary to prevent a public health nuisance.

Construction of Fences, Pools, Buildings within the Village

If you plan to construct a fence, pool, building (shed/house) you **MUST** complete a Zoning Application. Forms can be found on the Village Website (www.pleasanthillohio.com). If you have questions, please contact the Village Office at 937-676-3241. Applications must be submitted to the Village Office by the third Wednesday of the Month for review on the third Thursday by the Planning Commission.

If you are going to fill a swimming pool this year, please make sure that you complete a Pool Fill Worksheet **BEFORE** you fill the pool.

The Pool Fill Worksheet is located on the back side of this sheet, on the Village Website or can be picked up at the Village Office. The worksheet must be submitted to the Village Office prior to filling the pool. A Village employee will contact the homeowner and schedule a time for an initial meter reading and will complete a follow-up meter reading 48 hours after the pool has been filled. If the Village Office is not contacted before the pool fill, no water/sewer credit will be applied to the next billing cycle.
