Sidewalk Safety Program

In an effort to promote safety, as well as improve the appearance of our neighborhoods, the Village of Pleasant Hill will be implementing a Sidewalk Repair Program in 2021. Sidewalks are an essential asset to the community that provide safe routes to schools, residential areas, commercial establishments, and more. Repair or replacement of unsafe sidewalks. Unsafe or defective sidewalks could be: Raised (3/4 of an inch or more); Settled (3/4 of an inch or more); excessively tilted; badly cracked or badly deteriorated. More information forthcoming.

Village Street Sweeping

Starting May 11th, the Village has contracted to have the streets swept. Street Sweeping provides two primary benefits to the village. The more obvious benefit is the collection and removal of paper, leaves, and other visible debris that collect in the gutters. This debris can block storm water facilities, causing localized flooding during heavy rains. An equally important, but less visible benefit is the removal of metal particles and other hazardous waste products left by passing vehicles. Although they are virtually invisible, these particles can be extremely harmful to fish and other wildlife if they reach our creeks and rivers.

The Village encourages residents to move their parked cars off the street before the sweeping date to allow street sweeping crews enough space to clean the streets.
