Attention Village Residents

Village Ordinance 1074: An Ordinance relating to prohibiting yard waste and/or leaves in curb gutters and repealing ordinance No. 1029. **Section One:** It is not permissible at any time to sweep, blow, or otherwise place or dispose of grass or vegetation clippings, branches or other yard waste onto sidewalks, streets, curb gutters or other public rights of way. **Section Two:** No owner or other person having care of or being in control of land shall allow grass or vegetation clippings, branches, or other yard waste to accumulate on said premises longer than one week, without properly disposing of said yard waste.

Reminder to Pet (Dog) Owners

All pet owners and keepers are requested to keep their pets on a leash and immediately and properly dispose of their pet's solid waste deposited on any property, public or private, not owned or possessed by the person. On any property owned or possessed by that person, all pet owners and keepers are requested to dispose of their pet's solid waste at a frequency of at least weekly or more frequently if necessary to prevent a public health nuisance.

Have you visited the Village Library...?

The Oakes-Beitman Memorial Library located in the heart of Pleasant Hill and serves Newton Township was established following a bequest by Pleasant Hill native Ellie Wampler who died in 1952. Mrs. Wampler bequeathed her home to be used as a public library with income for the operation of the library provided by funds generated by farmland also bequeathed by Mrs. Wampler. Ohio law prevented the establishment of a new public library district and income from the farm was insufficient, so the Oakes-Beitman Memorial Library board contracted with the Troy-Miami County Public Library to establish the library which opened in April 1957. The library offers study and meeting space, computers, limited print services, programming for all ages and much more. Print, digital, and audiovisual materials are available, along with nontraditional items like cake pans and puzzles.

Swimming Pool Filling

Summer is right around the corner and people are starting to think about filling their swimming pools... If you are going to fill a swimming pool this year, please make sure that you complete a Pool Fill Worksheet **BEFORE** you fill the pool. The Pool Fill Worksheet is located on the Village Website or can be picked up at the Village Office. The worksheet **must be** submitted to the Village Office prior to filling the pool. A Village employee will contact the homeowner and schedule a time for an initial meter reading and will complete a follow-up meter reading 48 hours after the pool has been filled. If the Village Office is **not contacted** before the pool is filled, **no water/sewer credit** will be applied to the next billing cycle.
