Village Ordinance 1013

An Ordinance to Prohibit Animals From Becoming A Nuisance In The Village Of Pleasant Hill

Section One - No owner, keeper, or harbinger of any animal shall allow such animal to annoy or disturb one or more of the inhabitants of 2 or more separate residences of this municipality by frequent or habitual howling, yelping, barking, or making of any other such noises by such animal within the corporation limits.

Section Two - No person being the owner of any animal or fowl, or harboring or having charge or control of the same, shall permit such animal or fowl to run unfettered in any street, lane, alley, market place or public ground of this municipality, or permit such animal or fowl to go upon or enter any private yard, lot, or enclosure, without consent of the owner of such yard, lot, or enclosure.

Section Three - No person shall keep any pig, horse, cow, goat, poultry, three or more dogs at least three months of age, or three or more cats at least 3 months of age, within the corporation limits or harbor any animals or fowl so as to create noxious or offensive odors or unsanitary conditions which are a menace to the health, comfort or safety of the public.

Village Residents – Ordinance 1013 has been explicitly identified, due to a vast population of cats running freely within the Village limits. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

Reminder to Pet (Dog) Owners

All pet owners and keepers are requested to immediately and properly dispose of their pet's solid waste deposited on any property, public or private, not owned or possessed by the person. On any property owned or possessed by that person, all pet owners and keepers are requested to dispose of their pet's solid waste at a frequency of at least weekly or more frequently if necessary to prevent a public health nuisance.

Village Street Sweeping - May 17th, 2021

On May 17th, the Village has contracted to have the streets swept. We will do our best to notify residents of the actual date, which will be based off of weather. Notification will be provided on the Village Website and Village Facebook page.

Street Sweeping provides two primary benefits to the village. The more obvious benefit is the collection and removal of paper, leaves, and other visible debris that collect in the gutters. This debris can block storm water facilities, causing localized flooding during heavy rains. An equally important, but less visible benefit is the removal of metal particles and other hazardous waste products left by passing vehicles. Although they are virtually invisible, these particles can be extremely harmful to fish and other wildlife if they reach our creeks and rivers. The Village encourages residents in the designated areas to move their parked cars off the street before the sweeping date to allow street sweeping crews room to clean streets.

Reminder: Village Street Construction – Spring/Summer 2021

Village Residents, there will be street construction on the following streets: No Name Street, South Maple Street, South Long Street, East Franklin and East Grace Street. If you are going to fill a swimming pool this year, please make sure that you complete a Pool Fill Worksheet **BEFORE** you fill the pool.

The Pool Fill Worksheet is located on the back side of this sheet, on the Village Website or can be picked up at the Village Office. The worksheet must be submitted to the Village Office prior to filling the pool. A Village employee will contact the homeowner and schedule a time for an initial meter reading and will complete a follow-up meter reading 48 hours after the pool has been filled. If the Village Office is not contacted before the pool fill, no water/sewer credit will be applied to the next billing cycle.
