

The Pleasant Hill Board of Public Affairs meeting focused on leadership appointments, utility billing updates, and ongoing infrastructure planning for village services.

Key Highlights from the January 22, 2025 Pleasant Hill Village Council Meeting

- The Pleasant Hill village council Board of Public Affairs elected Stan Fessler as President and Lenny Wirz as Vice President for the year.
- The board approved December financial reports, meeting minutes, and payment records through the consent agenda.
- The village removed fees for ACH utility payments to encourage more residents to use automatic billing options.
- A total of 59 late utility payments were reported for January, highlighting ongoing billing challenges.
- The village plans to include ACH signup information in the next newsletter to improve on-time utility payments.
- Officials are working to obtain another quote for a wastewater study to support future utilities planning.
- Monthly sewer and water flow reports were reviewed to monitor system performance and capacity.
- A frozen pressure sensor at the water tower triggered a system alert, showing the importance of maintaining infrastructure equipment.
- Village staff are finalizing 2024 finances and preparing the 2025 budget and appropriations.
- Routine street clearing and public works efforts were noted as part of ongoing village operations.
