

The Pleasant Hill Board of Public Affairs meeting focused on equipment upgrades, utility system maintenance, and upcoming service activities affecting residents.

Key Highlights from the June 16, 2025 Pleasant Hill Village Council Meeting

- The Pleasant Hill village council Board of Public Affairs approved May financial reports and prior meeting minutes through the consent agenda.
- The village approved the purchase of a new sewer jetter for \$65,000 to replace outdated equipment and improve sewer system maintenance.
- The old sewer jetter from 1988 is no longer usable or supported, making replacement necessary for reliable utilities service.
- Monthly flow reports were reviewed to track sewer system performance and overall utilities usage.
- The village identified a safety concern with a drum flipper and plans to replace it with safer equipment.
- A draft of the annual Consumer Confidence Report was prepared to keep residents informed about water quality.
- Hydrant flushing was scheduled for early July, with notice that residents may experience temporary discolored water.
- Routine infrastructure maintenance like hydrant flushing helps maintain water quality and system reliability.
- A potential new concession stand and restroom facility near the soccer fields was mentioned as part of community planning.
