Citizens Comments:

Mr. Wheelock asked to address Council about a letter he received from the Village. The letter instructed him that placing his trash bin in front of his house to prevent others from parking was not lawful. Mr. Wheelock stated that he did so for safety. When vehicles park in front of his house, it is difficult to see traffic while pulling out of his drive. He was almost in an accident last year. This has been even more concerning due to the increased traffic from the coffee shop.

The neighbor across the street has five vehicles and frequently park in front of his house. There has been some hostility over the parking situation in this neighborhood. Mr. Wheelock stated that he will continue to place the trash can in front of his house to prevent others from parking there. He thanked Council for their time, and did not stay for the remainder of the meeting.

- Crystal: JFD reported permits were issued for Lights up the Night and was preparing for EMS coverage of the event


Adjournment

There being no other business brought forth to Council, the Mayor stated that she would entertain a motion to adjourn. Faith made a motion to adjourn. Penny seconded the motion.


