Electric and Natural Gas Aggregation ready to sign up!

If you haven't received a letter in the mail, it's probably because you had a current contract with another supplier, if you want to change to aggregate program, follow the info. below!

Electric Aggregation

The new electric supplier is with Dynegy Energy Services beginning with the December 2025 meter read date at a fixed rate of **9.59 cents per kWh**, until the December 2026 meter read date There is no early termination fee. The Village of Pleasant Hill is included in the Electric Aggregation Program of Miami County.

Natural Gas Aggregation

The County renewed with IGS Energy for a 24-month term at a fixed rate of **\$6.82 per MCF (\$0.682 per ccf)** starting with the November 2025 billing. There is no early termination fee.

△ When to Drip

- Temperature below 20°F for several hours
- Power outages

Where to Drip

- **Faucets farthest from main shutoff**
- Cold water lines in:
 - Crawl spaces
 - Basements

 - Garages
 - Attics
 - Exterior walls

1. **Choose the Right Faucet** – End of line, exposed area
2. **Open Cabinets** – Let warm air in
3. **Set the Drip** – Slow, steady (“drip, drip, drip”)
4. **Focus on Cold Water** – Most exposed

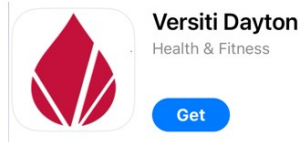
