

VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, OHIO

ORDINANCE 1048

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT PARKING A TRAILER, MOTOR HOME, HOUSE TRAILER OR BOAT ON ANY VILLAGE STREET

WHEREAS, the parking of trailers, motor homes, house trailers and boats parked on village streets is a safety hazard, and;

WHEREAS, the parking of trailers, motor homes, house trailers and boats parked on village streets is esthetically undesirable;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio:


SECTION ONE: That no person shall park a trailer, motor home, house trailer, or boat on any street in the Village of Pleasant Hill for more than 48 hours.

SECTION TWO: That any violation of this ordinance shall be a minor misdemeanor. Each 48 hour period of violation constitutes a separate offense.


SECTION THREE: That Ordinance 934 is hereby repealed.


