ORDINANCE 1058

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING RECREATIONAL DEVICES IN LIBRARY
COURTYARD AT NW CORNER OF MAIN AND MONUMENT STREET

WHEREAS, there has been a marked increase in the use of recreational devices such as skateboards, roller blades, and bicycles in the library courtyard.

WHEREAS, the use of such equipment has caused damage and soiling of the surfaces of the library courtyard and its structures.

WHEREAS, use of such designated devices gives rise to a potential risk of liability to the Village of Pleasant Hill;

WHEREAS, restrictions on the use of such recreational devices is necessary to insure proper ingress and egress to the library courtyard and other lawful use thereof, and to prevent damage to and the soiling of the library courtyard premises and structures;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio:

SECTION ONE: No person shall use any skates, skateboards, roller blades, or other recreational devices, or ride a bicycle or other self-propelled vehicles in the library courtyard, its steps, fountains, or structures

SECTION TWO: The courtyard does not include the perimeter sidewalks.

SECTION THREE: Any violation of this Ordinance shall be a minor misdemeanor.
