ORDINANCE NO. 1072

AN ORDINANCE FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio has adopted a Resolution of Necessity (Resolution 2012-01) in accordance with Section 727.12 of the Ohio Revised Code;

WHEREAS, the time for filing claims for damages has expired; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio has determined to proceed with the improvement referenced in its Resolution of Necessity.

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, has awarded a contract for the project and the contractor will be starting on or about April 1, 2012.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO AT LEAST THREE FOURTHS OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THEREFORE CONCURRING:


SECTION ONE: The Village of Pleasant Hill intends to proceed with the improvement in accordance with the provisions of the Resolution of Necessity adopted under Section 727.12 of the Ohio Revised Code for the Improvement of South Main Street.


SECTION TWO: The Village of Pleasant Hill hereby adopts the estimated assessment prepared and filed in accordance with the Resolution of Necessity.

SECTION THREE: Any claims for damages filed in accordance with Section 727.18 of the Ohio Revised Code shall not be judicially inquired into before commencing or after completing the proposed improvement.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio and in that improvements to S. Main Street will begin on or about April 1, 2012. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
