

VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 1074

AN ORDINANCE RELATING PROHIBITING YARD WASTE AND/OR LEAVES IN CURB GUTTERS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1029

WHEREAS, placing leaves and yard waste into curb gutters clogs the gutters creating unsafe and unsanitary conditions; and

WHEREAS, to prevent unnecessary waste from entering the curb gutters;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO AT LEAST THREE FOURTHS OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THERETO CONCURRING:

SECTION ONE: It is not permissible at any time to sweep, blow, or otherwise place or dispose of grass or vegetation clippings, branches or other yard waste onto sidewalks, streets, curb gutters or other public rights of way.

SECTION TWO: No owner or other person having care of or being in control of land shall allow grass or vegetation clippings, branches or other yard waste to accumulate on said premises longer than one week, without properly disposing of said yard waste.


SECTION THREE: To assist owners or other persons having care of or being in control of properties inside the Village, the Village will have an annual leaf pick-up program. The Village will designate and post the dates for this program. All leaves must be bagged in regular trash bags no larger than 50 gallon size and placed at the lawn side of the curb.


SECTION FOUR: A violation of this Ordinance shall be a minor misdemeanor.

SECTION FIVE: That Ordinance No. 1029 is hereby repealed.

SECTION SIX: That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio, and to make this Ordinance effective for the upcoming Spring and Summer seasons, therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
