

**VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, OHIO**

**ORDINANCE NO. 1076**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO DESIGNATING THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTH LONG STREET AND EAST HILL STREET AS A MULTI-WAY STOP INTERSECTION, TO BE CONTROLLED BY STOP SIGNS AND AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio upon request by residents of the Village, has determined that it is in the best interest of the safety and welfare of children living in the vicinity of that intersection and the public traveling upon the streets of the Village that the intersection of South Long Street and East Hill Street be designated as a multi-stop intersection.


**BE IT ORDAINED**, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO AT LEAST THREE FOURTHS OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THEREFORE CONCURRING:


**SECTION ONE:** That the intersection of South Long Street and East Hill Street in the Village of Pleasant Hill, is designated a multi-stop intersection. Stop signs shall be erected at the intersection directing persons traveling through the intersection from all directions to stop before entering the intersection of said streets in accordance with corresponding sections of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION TWO:** That all Ordinances and Resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby modified to be consistent with this Ordinance.

**SECTION THREE:** That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio for the aforementioned reasons and because traffic has significantly increased during the reconstruction of S. Main Street. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
