

VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 1105

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO ESTABLISHING THAT THE WEST SIDE OF NORTH MAIN STREET FROM THE CORNER OF MAIN AND MONUMENT STREET TO THE ALLEY BETWEEN THE OAKES BEITMAN MEMORIAL LIBRARY AND THE APRARTMENT BUILDING AT 16 NORTH MAIN STREET BE LIMITED TO ONE HOUR PARKING DURING LIBRARY HOURS AND AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS FOR THE LIMITED PARKING ZONE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Tenants from the apartment buildings on North Main Street park their vehicles on the street in front of the Oakes Beitman Memorial Library for days without moving them and making it difficult for customers of the Library to find ample parking space when they are visiting the Library.

WHEREAS, Library management and customers have filed numerous complaints about parking space availability during Library hours and the hardship it creates for families using the Library.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO AT LEAST TWO THIRD OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THEREFORE CONCURRING:

SECTION ONE: That parking on the West Side of North Main Street from the intersection of North Main and West Monument to the alley just north of the Oakes Beitman Memorial Library property shall be limited to One Hour (1 hour) during Library Hours.


SECTION TWO: That the Council herby authorizes the installation of traffic signs for the limited parking zone.

SECTION THREE: That all Ordinances and Resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby modified to be consistent with this Ordinance.


SECTION FOUR: That any violation of this ordinance shall be a minor misdemeanor.

SECTION FIVE: That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio for the aforementioned reasons and therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
