

VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 1108

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO ESTABLISHING THAT THE FIRST EIGHTY FEET (80 FEET) OF THE WEST SIDE OF NORTH MAIN STREET BEGINNING AT THE CURB ON THE NORTH SIDE OF WEST HIGH STREET AS A NO PARKING ZONE, TO BE CONTROLLED BY YELLOW CURB; AND AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A TRAFFIC SIGN FOR THE NO PARKING ZONE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Individuals currently park their vehicles too close to the entrance of the Post Office parking lot and contribute to a traffic hazard for drivers entering the Post Office parking lot from the North. Further, some vehicles that parking in the proposed “no parking zone” area block the line of sight for drivers entering North Main Street from West High Street.


THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO AT LEAST TWO THIRD OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THEREFORE CONCURRING:


SECTION ONE: That no parking shall be permitted on North Main Street beginning at the curb on the north side of West High Street to eighty feet (80 feet) north on Main Street. Further, this Ordinance authorizes installing a sign stating that parking from the sign to the corner is not permitted.

SECTION TWO: That all Ordinances and Resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby modified to be consistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio for the aforementioned reasons and that this will allow the Village of Pleasant Hill to immediately increase the “No Parking Zone” at this intersection and reduce the traffic hazards described above.
