AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING COUNCIL APPROVAL FOR THE PLACING OF ANY DECORATIONS OR SIGNAGE ON THE PLEASANT HILL CIVIL WAR MONUMENT

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds it necessary to protect the venerated Civil War Monument located at the intersection of Monument and Main Streets, from being utilized as a signpost for placards, posters or seasonal decorations. and,

WHEREAS, the Monument is a testament to the lives given during the greatest conflict on American soil and must be safeguarded from any other intent.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, THE MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THERETO CONCURRING:

SECTION ONE: APPLICABILITY:

The council will regulate all attachments to the Civil War Monument including but not limited to wreathes, planters, and memorials. Council will make any and all decisions regarding to attachments or commemorations. Council will make all decisions with objectivity and without any partiality.
