ORDINANCE NO. 1118

AN ORDINANCE ELIMINATING REFUSE SERVICE TO COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES AND R-4 RESIDENCES

WHEREAS: The Pleasant Hill Council finds it necessary to discontinue refuse services to commercially zoned and multi-residentially zoned R-4 properties in the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio;

WHEREAS: The Pleasant Hill Council finds that adopting an ordinance eliminating this refuse service will allow the owners of these properties to source refuse disposal necessary to their businesses and land use.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council for the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio, a majority of the members elected or appointed thereto concurring:

SECTION ONE: That the properties as currently defined by the Miami County Engineers Office will be impacted by this ordinance.

SECTION TWO: The Pleasant Hill Council will not grant any allowances for any owner of properties that are zoned commercial or R-4 residences.

SECTION THREE - PENALTY: First violation of this Ordinance is a minor misdemeanor as defined by the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION FOUR - SUBSEQUENT VIOLATIONS: Each subsequent violation of this Ordinance is a misdemeanor of the fourth degree as defined by the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time permitted by law.
