ORDINANCE NO. 1126

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO DESIGNATING THE INTERSECTION OF EAST FRANKLIN STREET AND LONG STREET AS A STOP INTERSECTION, TO BE CONTROLLED BY A STOP SIGN AND AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio has determined that it is in the best interest of the safety and welfare of children living in the vicinity of that intersection and the public traveling upon the streets of the Village that the intersection of East Franklin Street and South Long Street be designated as a stop intersection.


BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO AT LEAST THREE FOURTHS OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THEREFORE CONCURRING:

SECTION ONE: That the intersection of East Franklin Street and South Long Street in the Village of Pleasant Hill, is designated a stop intersection. Stop signs shall be installed on Franklin Street at the intersection directing persons traveling east and west on Franklin Street to stop before entering Long Street at the intersection of said streets in accordance with corresponding sections of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION TWO: That all Ordinances and Resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby modified to be consistent with this Ordinance.


