ORDINANCE NO. 1140

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO DESIGNATING THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTH CHURCH STREET AND WEST FRANKLIN STREET AS A MULTI-WAY STOP INTERSECTION, TO BE CONTROLLED BY A STOP SIGN AND AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION.**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill has determined that it is in the best interest of the safety and welfare of children living in the vicinity of that intersection and public traveling upon the streets of the Village that the intersection of South Church Street and West Franklin Street be designated as a multi-way stop intersection.

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO AT LEAST THREE FOURTHS OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THEREFORE CONCURRING:

**SECTION ONE:** That the intersection of South Church Street and West Franklin Street in the Village of Pleasant Hill, is designated a multi-way stop intersection. A stop sign shall be installed on South Church Street before entering West Franklin Street at the intersection of said streets in accordance with corresponding sections of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION TWO:** That all Ordinances and Resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby modified to be consistent with this Ordinance.
