

VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 1155

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO PROHIBITING SOLICITATION AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 957.

WHEREAS, Solicitation within the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio has become a nuisance and;

WHEREAS, a limitation on solicitation is necessary for the protection of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO with a majority of the members elected or appointed thereto concurring;

SECTION ONE: That no person, firm, or corporation shall engage in the business or activity of a peddler, solicitor, canvasser, itinerant vendor, or transient dealer within the municipality.

SECTION TWO: That this Ordinance shall not apply to any organization located in the Village of Pleasant Hill or Newton Township including but not limited to Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, 4-H clubs, Newton School sanctioned activities and groups sanctioned by churches located within the Village or Township.

SECTION THREE: Organizations located in the Village not specifically listed in Section Two of this Ordinance may give notice of their intention to solicit by sending written notice to the Mayor of the Village of Pleasant Hill thirty days prior to the first date of solicitation.

SECTION FOUR: That any Ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance shall be deemed modified to be consistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: PENALTY: Whoever violates the provisions of this Ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor for the first offense. A second offense is a misdemeanor of the fourth degree; and more than two offenses, a misdemeanor of the third degree for each offense.
