ORDINANCE NO. 1156

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO REGULATING TRASH CONTAINERS.

WHEREAS, it has been determined to be in the best interest of the residents of the Village of Pleasant Hill, and to conform with surrounding Municipalities standards to provide a more specific regulation on trash containers/bins;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE PLEASANT HILL, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO with a majority of the members elected or appointed thereto concurring;

SECTION ONE: Trash/recycling must be placed in provided bins curbside the night before your scheduled collection. Bins are to be removed from curbside the same day of pick up. Trash is collected in the Village weekly, and recycling is collected biweekly. Curbside recycling program is provided to keep more waste out of landfills. To confirm your biweekly schedule, refer to the Village website www.pleasanthillohio.com, or Village office.

SECTION TWO: Large item pick up must be arranged with the pickup company at least 72 hours prior to the trash collection day. Items may have specific instructions that must be followed. If the large items are not picked up by the collection team, they **MUST** be removed by the resident from the curbside.

SECTION THREE: Bins shall **NOT** be stored on a sidewalk/right-of-way.

SECTION FOUR: PENALTY: If resident does not comply with this Ordinance, the resident/owner will be charged with a misdemeanor violation, for each day of violation after violation notification received.
