

Cyber Security Ordinance
Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio
Ordinance No. 1171

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT A CYBERSECURITY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, this is a requirement of Ohio House Bill 96 which requires all political subdivisions to create a cybersecurity program.

WHEREAS, record, documents or report related to the Cybersecurity Program and its framework are not public records under ORC 9.64 and it is considered best practice to not release the details of any policy concerning Cybersecurity Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Village of Pleasant Hill is hereby authorized to adopt the Village of Pleasant Hill Cybersecurity Policy.

SECTION 2. Consistent with ORC 9.64, the Village of Pleasant Hill's Cybersecurity Policy is not public record and not subject to review by the public.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
