ORDINANCE 939

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A THIRTY (30) MINUTE PARKING ZONE AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the parking of vehicles at 200 North Main Street is a safety hazard,
and;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County,
Ohio:

SECTION ONE: That a thirty (30) minute parking zone is hereby declared at
200 North Main Street in the village of Pleasant Hill.


SECTION TWO: That any violation of this ordinance shall be a minor
misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than one
hundred dollars (\$100.00). Each 24 hour period of violation
constitutes a separate offense.


SECTION THREE: That all ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this
Ordinance are hereby modified consistent with this Ordinance.


SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the
health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of
Pleasant Hill, Ohio for the reason that said Ordinance will
alleviate an unsafe condition that occurs on an ongoing basis
and therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately
upon its passage.
