**ORDINANCE 940**

**AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE AN ANGLED PARKING ZONE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the parking of vehicles on streets surrounding Church Street is a safety hazard, and;

WHEREAS, the allowance of angled parking will relieve the parking burden on the surrounding streets;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio:


SECTION ONE: That an angled parking parking zone is hereby declared at Church Street in the village of Pleasant Hill between Monument Street and the alley behind the UCC church.

SECTION TWO: That all ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby modified to be consistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio for the reason that said Ordinance will alleviate an unsafe condition that occurs on an ongoing basis and therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
