ORDINANCE 943

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE NO PARKING ZONES

WHEREAS, the parking of vehicles at various streets in the Village is a safety hazard;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio, a majority of its members elected or appointed therefore concurring as follows:

SECTION ONE: That there shall be no parking on the east side of Williams Street along lots 131 and 142 in the village of Pleasant Hill.


SECTION TWO: That any violation of this ordinance shall be a minor misdemeanor. Each 24 hour period of violation constitutes a separate offense.


SECTION THREE: That any violation of this ordinance shall be a minor misdemeanor. Each 24 hour period of violation constitutes a separate offense.


SECTION FOUR: That all ordinances and resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby modified consistent with this Ordinance.


