VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL, OHIO

ORDINANCE 951

AN ORDINANCE TO CONTROL RECKLESS OPERATION;
CONTROL COURSE AND SPEED
IN THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds and declares that reckless operation and control of course and speed is a major safety issue and in Pleasant Hill; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds that adopting a reckless operation and control of course and speed ordinance is in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Pleasant Hill; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, a majority of the members elected or appointed thereto concurring.

SECTION ONE: Without due regard for the safety and rights of pedestrians and drivers and occupants of all other vehicles, and so as to endanger the life, limb or property of any person while in the lawful use of the streets or sidewalks or any other public or private property;

SECTION TWO: Without exercising reasonable and ordinary control over such bicycle;

SECTION THREE: In a weaving or zigzag course unless such irregular course is necessary for safe operation in compliance with law;

SECTION FOUR: Without both hands upon the handle grips except when necessary to give the required hand and arm signals;

SECTION FIVE: At a speed greater than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions that exist.

SECTION SIX: Whoever violates this Section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

SECTION SEVEN: This ordinance shall take affect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
