ORDINANCE 132

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING "U" TURNS
IN THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL

2022.1.13 Passed

WHEREAS, the Village of Pleasant Hill desires to have its code conform with current standards for the safety of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds and declares that "U" turns present a safety concern when conducted inappropriately in Pleasant Hill; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds that adopting an ordinance is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Pleasant Hill; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, a majority of the members elected or appointed thereto concurring.

SECTION ONE: Turns in the Village of Pleasant Hill. It shall be unlawful to turn any vehicle so as to proceed in the opposite direction where a sign prohibits such movement.

SECTION TWO: No vehicle shall be turned so as to proceed in the opposite direction upon any curve, or upon the approach to, or near the crest of a grade, where such vehicle cannot be seen by the driver of any other vehicle approaching from either direction within 500 feet, or at any other location unless such movement can be made in safety and without backing or otherwise interfering with traffic. (O.R.C. 4511.37)

SECTION THREE: Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. For the penalty, see Title Six, Chapter 7, 1050.

SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall take affect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
