ORDINANCE 966

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2002 APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 956, BY DECREASING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE STREET AND MAINTENANCE FUND BY ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY SIX AND TWENTY CENTS, AND DECREASING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE REFUSE FUND BY ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY TWO AND SEVEN CENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village of Pleasant Hill desires to amend the fiscal year 2002 appropriations.


BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County , Ohio


SECTION ONE: That the appropriation for fiscal year 2002 in the Street and Maintenance fund be decreased by One Hundred Seventy Six and Twenty Cents (\$176.20).

SECTION TWO: That the appropriation for fiscal year 2002 in the Refuse fund be decreased by One Thousand Sixty Two and Seven Cents. (\$1,562.07).

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance be and hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio for the reason that said Ordinance will amend the fiscal appropriation for the year 2002, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage
