

VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL

ORDINANCE 968

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL CERTIFICATE OF ESTIMATED RESOURCES, ORDINANCE 968. THE ONLY CHANGE WILL BE IN FUNDS AND WILL NOT AFFECT THE TOTAL APPROPRIATION. THE PLEASANT HILL INCOME TAX WAS PUT IN GENERAL FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25, 000.00 AND SHOULD BE REMOVED AND PUT IN THE PLEASANT HILL INCOME TAX, IN THE FICIDUARY FUNDS, AND PASSED AS AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: The Village of Pleasant Hill desires to amend the official certificate of estimated resources, Ordinance 968.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Ohio.

SECTION ONE: To amend the official certificate of estimated resources, that the \$25,000.00 that was appropriated in the General Fund be removed from the General fund and placed in the Pleasant Hill Income Tax Fund, in Fiduciary Funds, making the General fund total resources available \$250,849.62.


SECTION TWO: To amend the official certificate of estimated resources, that the \$25,000.00 in the General fund for Income Tax be removed and put in the Pleasant Hill Income Tax Fund, in Fiduciary Funds, making the Pleasant Hill Income Tax Fund in Fiduciary Funds total resources available \$51,401.20.


SECTION THREE: That the amended certificate will remain the same amount for a total of \$1,466,365.50.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance be and hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation for the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Pleasant Hill, Ohio for the reason that said ordinance will amend the official certificate of estimated resources, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
